The Center for the Arts will be a multi-use space with guests coming and going for classes, performances and rehearsals. Artists will be juried by a panel of artists and non-artists. Artists will be vetted by the application, Letter of Intent and Images of your body of work. The City of Greer reserves the right to choose artists that meet our vision for the facility.

Up to four student artists will share a large studio at the Center for the Arts, free of charge. Student artists will be expected to perform certain duties (such as cleaning the classrooms, loading/firing/unloading the kiln, taking out trash, etc.) in exchange for their studio space. They will also be expected to work in their studio for six hours each week.

Submit 5-10 images electronically via email. Images should be examples of your most recent work. Include a summary page that lists the title, size, medium and date of each piece. If you have a website or a Facebook/Instagram page for your artwork, please include that as well.
